A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend an Act to make provisions for the Magistrate Court of Jenkins County, approved
- 2 March 12, 1984 (Ga. L. 1984, p. 4111), so as to provide for the appointment of deputy
- 3 magistrates; to provide for such appointment to be made by the county governing authority;
- 4 to provide terms for the chief magistrate and deputy magistrates as provided by law; to repeal
- 5 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 An Act to make provisions for the Magistrate Court of Jenkins County, approved March 12,
- 9 1984 (Ga. L. 1984, p. 4111), is amended by revising Section 1 as follows:
- 10 "Section 1. The number of magistrates authorized for Jenkins County shall be one chief
- magistrate and such deputy magistrates as deemed necessary by the county governing
- authority. The chief magistrate in office on the effective date of this Act shall serve out
- the term for which he was appointed. Successors to said chief magistrate and any deputy
- magistrate shall be appointed by the county governing authority for a term as provided
- by O.C.G.A. § 15-10-20 or as otherwise provided by law."

16 **SECTION 2.**

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
